



2008 Washington State Prevention Summit Participant Code of Conduct

Youth must bring an original and two (2) copies of this completed form with them to the onsite check-in desk. (One copy is kept with the youth; one is to be in the chaperone's possession and one copy filed at the registration desk. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.) **This form must be submitted for every youth participant at the time of on-site check-in. If the youth is under the age of 18 a legal parent or legal guardian must sign for the youth.**

Note: *Without this completed form in hand youth will be denied entrance into the Summit.

The goal of the **Washington State Prevention Summit** is to provide a safe, fun and positive environment in which youth and adults can learn and gain skills. As a youth attendee, I realize that I play a valuable role in attaining this goal and I promise to follow the following guidelines:

- I will obey all Yakima Convention Center rules, as well as all rules established by the hotel I am staying in, the Summit Staff and my chaperone.
- I will treat all others with respect.
- I will leave the hotel and workshop rooms as I found them.
- I will participate in summit activities to the best of my abilities.
- I will listen to others.
- I will not engage in violent behavior.
- I will not use or bring tobacco, alcohol or other illegal substances while at the conference.
- I will not engage in sexual behavior while attending the conference.

I understand violation of the Code of Conduct will result in consequences for my behavior. Consequences may include:

- Not being able to participate in Summit activities and spending time with my chaperone
- My Parent/Guardian will be notified and I could be sent home from the Summit at my own expense.*
